

NIFTY (WEEKLY)



The Week That Went By:

Continuing its positive momentum, Indian Market commenced its day on a firm note with a gap-up opening of 50 points above 10,900 but failed to hold at the higher levels and erased all its gains. Index oscillated in both the direction for the rest of the day. On day2, Following the mixed market, Indian Bourses started its day on a flat note. Ahead of the monetary policy, market participants remained cautious which has resulted in a range bound session for the day. On Wednesday, With the deep cut in the US markets and weak trade in Asian market, Indian Bourses kicked off the day on a negative note with a gap-down opening of 50 points. Index tried to stabilize but after the MPC meeting outcome sharp fall was observed in the market. On a weekly expiry day, Negative trade continued around the globe as Indian Bourses followed the weak Asian Market with a gap-down opening of 60 points well below 10,750. After the gap-down opening, Index extended its losses. An attempt of recovery vanished as next round of selling took place in the last session. On the last day of the week, after the strong opening, Index extended its gains and ended the session at the high point of the day.

MARKET OUTLOOK

After the eventful week, Nifty50 has made a bearish candlestick pattern– Dark Cloud Cover. Auto and Energy sectors made bearish engulfing pattern whereas Dark Cloud Cover pattern has been observed in the Media and FMCG sectors. It is too early to conclude that Nifty and NiftyBank is making a probable right shoulder of the Head and shoulder pattern

Nifty has immediate resistance of 10750-10790. On the downside 10500 hold as an immediate support. Bank Nifty has a stiff resistance of 27050 whereas support is placed around 26000.

SECTORAL GAINER



IT sector mildly outperformed the Major Indices. Major gainers were OFSS(+4.08%) and Wipro(+2.66%). Heavyweight stocks like INFY and TCS also ended the week with a gains of (+2.29%) and (+1.36%) respectively. On the other side, HCL Tech(-5.22%) and Tech Mahindra(-1.65%) were the underperformers.

SECTORAL LOSER



With the sharp cut over 6, Pharma sector underperformed the Benchmark Index. Major loser was Sun Pharma which ended the week with a deep cut of (-16.51%). Other components such as AuroPharma, Lupin and Cipla ended the week with a cut of (-7.32%), (-5.12%) and (-5.03%) respectively. As a exception Divis Labs was the outperformer with a gain of (+3.64%).
