

**NIFTY (Weekly)**



**The week that went by:**

Continuing the negative momentum, Indian market kicked off the day on a flat note with a negative bias. Index continued to skid lower and compounded its losses throughout the day; mainly dragged by Pharma and Auto stocks. On day 2, Post the flat opening, Index slipped below 10500; however bounced from the same in the morning trade itself and oscillated in a tight range of 10515-10550 throughout the day. On Wednesday, Following the weak Asian peers, Indian market kicked off the day on a flat note with a negative bias. Index tumbled in the morning trade itself due to the fall in the OMC's and metal stocks. Nifty tried to stabilize in the afternoon session but selling pressure intensified in the last session. On the weekly expiry day, Amid mixed trade in Asian Market, Indian market kicked off the day on a strong note with a gap-up opening of 30 points. Post the knee-jerk reaction in the morning trade, Index continued to soar higher; well supported by the IT stocks. Nifty extended its gains in the last session due to short covering in the Banking stocks. On the last day of the week, Index opened higher and continued to extend its gains; well supported by the Metal and Auto stocks.

Nifty50 has made a Dragonfly DOJI candlestick pattern which represents the smart recovery from the lower levels. Success or failure of the pattern will be confirmed in the next week.

Nifty has immediate resistance of 10655 & 10730. On the downside 10430 hold as an immediate support. Bank Nifty has resistance of 26400 whereas support is placed around 25960.

For a time being underperformer turned out to be a outperformer i.e. PSU banking sector ended the week with the gains of almost 10% and outperformed the Benchmark Index. Major gainer was SBI(+10.52%) followed by Bank of Baroda(+10.33%) and PNB(+10.31%).

Adverse effect of the rising crude oil prices can be seen on the performance OMS's as Energy sector ended the week with the cut of (-1.56%). Major losers were HPCL(-5.69%) and ONGC(-5.47%). Sector is forming a probable bearish head and shoulder formation.
